## History of Jazz Outreach Program (Click to Learn More)

- Serves thousands of students, special groups, and older adults; educates about Jazz history through a creative live presentation
- Over 33,000 elementary/middle school students impacted since 2011 across 60 Bay Area schools - including Title I
- Program Cost: Approximately $\$ 700$ per visit

- CJH Online Education Resource
- A comprehensive History of Jazz video and audio (podcast) archive, part of the History of Jazz Outreach Program
- 204 Segments to Date
- Program Cost: Approximately $\$ 200$ per segment


## My Journey with Jazz Program (Click to Learn More)

- Jazz appreciation program delivered in a fun game format to after-care and summer camps in underserved communities, with a new in-school adaption
- A related online education resource, My Virtual Journey with Jazz, reinforces the program visits
- Over 900 students impacted since 2017 including over 1,800 family members and guests
- Program Cost: Approximately $\$ 2,300$ per program cycle (4 visits and a culminating program finale for families and special guests)


## Young Lions Jazz Master Sessions (Click to Learn More)

- A one-of-kind student instructional experience with group clinics, instrument master classes, and jam sessions involving university jazz educators and local jazz professionals
- Over 1,200 students impacted since 2016 from 51 participating school bands
- Program Cost:
- Annual Event: Approximately $\mathbf{\$ 1 1 , 0 0 0}$
- Year-Round In-School Visits: Approximately \$1,200 per visit
- Young Lions Jazz Master "Virtual" Sessions: Related online education archive of video and audio (podcast) instructional sessions; 302 segments to date; Each segment costs approximately \$150-\$250


## Give Them a Stage Program (Click to Learn More)

- Performance opportunities for young musicians and aspiring artists, helping to build confidence, hone their craft, network, and develop fans
- From 2018-Spring 2023 approximately 144 young artists participated across 106 unique performance opportunities reaching a collective audience of nearly 17,769 (not including the annual Clearwater Jazz Holiday music festival)
- Program Cost: Approximately \$75-\$200 per performer per performance opportunity (ensemble size varies).


## Guitar Lessons (Click to Learn More)

- Guitar donations and lessons to students in partner neighborhood family centers and other organizations
- Program Cost: Approximately $\$ 700$ for a cycle of seven lessons


## Special Funding (Click to Learn More)

- Supports youth music/Jazz education; annual contributions to school Jazz ensembles and band programs; scholarships to students with aspiring music, music education, and event production careers; Jazz camp scholarships; support to youth Jazz programs
- Program Cost: CJH will provide approximately $\$ 20,000$ in special funding in 2023
